### Educational Programs

- Platform Workshop/Elections Training-works with any member who wants to learn about the elections process and how to make a platform
- Seven Cardinal Principle/Five Fold Scavenger Hunt-each item will have a riddle that weaves the meaning of the Fold/Principle into the hunt for the next object
- Water Balloon Fight (In the warmer days)-Teams answer questions about the history of BBYO/AZA/Michigan Region/Fisher and they get a certain amount of water balloons for each correctly answered question
- Masada Dodge ball-The game of dodge ball will be preceded by an explanation of the Roman Siege of Masada. The game of dodge ball signifies the fighting between the Israelites and the Romans
- Jewpardy – A game of Jeopardy with Jewish, BBYO, and AZA questions that teach members everything about Judaism, and the organization of BBYO
- Capture the Flag - each team tries to capture the other teams flags by finding clues without being caught, each clue will tell about a different war in Jewish history

# GOALS & IDEAS

## Recruitment/Membership



### Have a Big Brother Little Brother program

Establish a bond between each AIT and a Fisher "veteran" to welcome them to the chapter and basically lead them through their first year. Also, it will bond the AITs with their fellow brothers.



### Welcome members who join late

When members join late, they will still be equipped with a big brother. This will enable them to hit the ground running and become a part of the chapter



### Enforce the 60-day rule in the constitution

Our chapter faces a deficit in recruitment because of the amount of juniors that are members; therefore we must enforce the 60-day rule only after our chapter is full



### Recruit from the corners of Michigan

To broaden the horizons of our chapter's diverse population will increase locations for functions and recruiting opportunities in the future.



### Recruiting Programs

Recruiting for future Fishermen will start earlier to give prospectives time to decide before the chapter starts filling up. It will also give us as a chapter a chance to meet these eighth graders before they are in the chapter

- Livonia Rec. Center Function - the Livonia Rec. Center has multiple activities that a prospective could participate in (obviously supervised) and it's cheap to get in!
- Snow Day! - Since recruiting takes place in the winter, why not take advantage of that? The function would be at someone's house with enough snow to play in. Members and prospectives could also go inside and recruit/warm up
- Massive Clue - A giant game of clue that uses members and prospective instead of pieces that encourages members to meet and welcome prospective members



### Race to Recruit

Members who get prospective to come to recruiting functions will earn a point for each prospective that comes, and three more points if that member joins. At the end of recruitment, members turn in points for prizes, such as fifteen points gets a spot at Bittker
