Break the chapter up into five groups and assign each group to a JARC home and schedule group visits once a month.

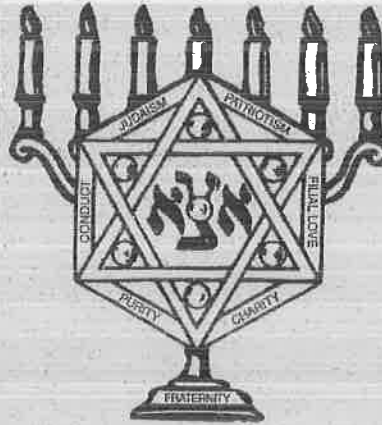
Plan a Meals on Wheels function with the Regional Shaliach at least twice during the programming year.

Plan a Shabbat dinner Once a month with fun programming, for example: Shabbat Dinner then swim party, or Limbo Scavenger hunt.

Plan a Havdalah Bon Fire with a BBG chapter with the addition of camp fire foods in order to make the program exciting.

For when there are services at conventions, work with the coordinators to make the services the best that I can.

Have prospective members help lead blessings at Havdalah dinners as well as Shabbat dinners, in order to give them more experience with Judaism and BBYO.

Plan a heritage including food from our culture; or hold an education program about each others cultures or heritages.
