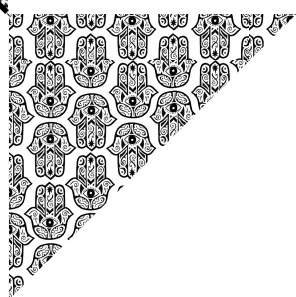
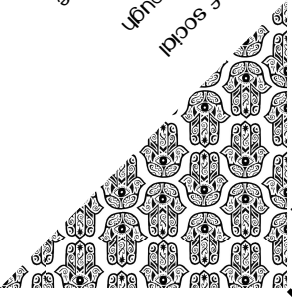

Social Action

Goal: Inspire members to advocate for causes they hold close to their hearts

- Choose new region-wide StandUp cause to advocate for throughout year
 - Programs at each convention based on it
 - Guide chapter counterparts in leading one program per term relating to this cause
- Build relationship with Stand With Us to further our region's role in Israel advocacy
- Encourage chapter participation in SPA programs (Service, Philanthropy, Advocacy)
- Increase regional presence at StandUp summer programs
- Recognize BBGs who have played significant role in social action across the community

Community Service

Goal: Increase BBYO's presence in community by helping those in need

- Further partnership with Keshet by bringing more teens to more events
 - At least one Keshet teen in each chapter
- Continue charity drive for Invite points
- End of year award to recognize members who have positively contributed to Jewish community
- Encourage all chapters to hold at least 1 community service event per term
- Send care packages to IDF
- Advertise community service opportunities going on in the area each month
- Implement/revitalize Tzedakah collection in each chapter
 - Competition for who can raise most money
 - Donate to regional StandUp cause

Jewish Heritage

Goal: Remind members of the one thing we all have in common, being Jewish, and spark a passion for Judaism in every BBG

- Improve services at conventions
 - Work with S'ganit to organize tracks including Saturday morning Services and rotation programs
 - Fun and inspiring themes to engage participants
- Monthly newsletter including information on Jewish holidays and current events
- Increased attendance at Global Shabbat, Seder to Remember, & J-Serve
- RLN Jewish Heritage/Education Committee
 - Teach Birkat & other prayers to increase involvement at all conventions
- Regional Kallah Convention
 - Programming based on Jewish values and ideals
 - Relaxed mindfulness programs offered to enhance Shabbat feeling
 - Inspiring social activists as guests
- Israel Week
 - Each chapter's programs revolve around Israel
 - Members who have been to Israel share experiences in GMR Facebook group
- Chapters each hold I-2 Shabbat/Havdallah programs per term
- Trivia on social media with incentives for first one to answer correctly
