Communication

- PDF releases are not 100% effective in and of themselves; spreading advice through the spoken word (e.g. counterpart-wide conf. calls, webinars, G+ chats) in conjunction with releases will resonate stronger with Regional & Council Mazkirim/Gizborim.
- Creating a unique sense of unity among the Mazkir/Gizbor community is a priority. Through an interactive blog, counterparts will be able to post successes and questions (via text or video). Posts will send direct notifications to the inboxes of every Mazkir and Gizbor within the counterpart network. Replies will allow those in the counterpart network to lend advice and share strategies on a more comprehensive platform than facebook.
- I intend to send out updates on a given Mazkir's successful methods of communication (and their impacts) to the counterpart network so that **every Mazkir can share the successes of our 89th year.**

Fundraising

- To allow for more effective regional/council fundraising, I'll make it my goal to create a **Program Bank-like system for fundraisers** (and programs that involve fundraising), OR add a fundraising subsection to the program bank and/or Stand Up website.
- Involve each region/council in ISF endeavors. Although every region makes an ISF pledge, the general membership should be behind that pledge; this involves globalization programming and an understanding of the importance of ISF (on the organization and the global Jewish community as a whole).
- Establish the **Degrees of Fundraising Excellence** to encourage effective and efficient fundraising (parallel to that of the Degrees of Program Excellence).

Globalization

- **Bring globalization to the roots!** Share global experiences on a regional/council level while showing the order the importance of ISF by bringing overseas teens to North American RC's (and vice versa).
- Work with the Global Networking Committee (GNC) to reevaluate, renovate, and revolutionize our approaches to ISF and globalization as a whole. This includes frequent conference calls with the GNC to assess and adjust to the changing global dynamic over the course of the year.
- Send at least **2** teens from **each global community** to a summer experience, international **event**, and/or RC.
- Add to B-linked an online store selling bumper stickers, tees, hoodies, sweats, and more the profits of which would go towards ISF.
