

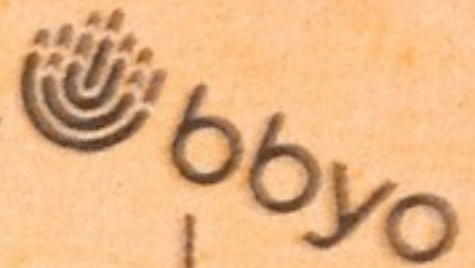

## Goals:

### Counterparts:

- § HELP each chapter Godol and not govern them.

- § PROMOTE the "Old to New" system where an older, more experienced member plans a program with an AIT or inexperienced member.

### Region

- § EDUCATE chapters about BBYO Connect and how to use it to each chapter's advantage.
- § GET Godol to talk to their cities' BBYO Connect members about BBYO so that they are well educated.
- § BEGIN CLTC promotion and education early to ensure that teens as well as parents hear about it ahead of time.
- § INCREASE regional attendance by 10%.
- § DEVELOP a relationship with every Aleph in Cotton States.
- § WORK with Kevin to have a concert at Winter Convention next year.
- § INVITE i-board members to come to regional programs.
- § Expand the region into Little Rock, Arkansas Jackson, Mississippi and Chattanooga, Tennessee.
- § IMPLEMENT an Apparel chair, allowing all Alephs to promote BBYO by wearing apparel.
- § RAISE regional funds by 15% by having new ideas for PEF/ISF.
- § SHOW the international order just how great Cotton States is!


## As Chapter S'gan:
