GOALS & IDEAS

Stand Up!:

- Work with the Stand Up! Reporting Chairmen to create Stand Up! months throughout the year. Each month will start off with a day of education about a specific aspect of Stand Up! through a conference call and release. During the rest of the month, regions/councils will be encouraged to plan a program or campaign based on that aspect of Stand Up!
 - November is "Stand Up! Education" month
 - December is "Service" month
 - 🌣 January is "Philanthropy" month
 - February is "Advocacy" month
- Regions/councils with the most Stand Up! education, service, philanthropy, and advocacy programs/campaigns, as well as the "Most Improved Stand Up! Campaign," will recieve awards at International Convention
- Work with regions/councils to set high but attainable goals, and to create a timeline that will be used to insure that these goals are met
- Work with the Grand Aleph S'gan to encourage and promote the use of the BBYO Program Bank for Stand Up! related programs
- Work with the Grand Aleph Shaliach to encourage the incorporation of Judaism in Stand Upl campaigns
- Keep the International Body updated on successful Stand Up! programs, fundraisers, and advocacy campaigns through both the Stand Up! group on Facebook and an account on Twitter

Stand Up! Reporting:

 Collect information about Stand Up!, including specific details about service events, fundraisers, and advocacy campaigns, on a weekly basis from regions/councils throughout the order

- Analyze all of the information about Stand Upl from the 2010-2011 programming year in order to continue implementing the successful aspects of the campaign next year while improving upon the weaker parts
- Use the collected information in order to pair regions/ councils with similar Stand Up! campaigns together, and have them work with one another to further their campaigns

Globalization:

 Increase awareness of and communication with our global regions through updates on the status of a different region

> every week, as well as a monthly newsletter with letters from members of global regions

- Educate and assist global regions with implementing simultaneous programming, such as AZA/BBG Shabbat and J-Serve, as well as initiatives including Stand Up! and emergency relief efforts
- Work individually with each global region in order to create the most effective and efficient system of communication possible
- Continue to promote and increase support for the International Service Fund in order to bring more teens from global regions to International Programs such as:
 - ☆ International Convention
 - ILTC/Int. Kallah
- Work with the Grand Aleph Moreh to promote and facilitate AZA/BBG education in global regions

Fundraising:

- Work with the Fundraising Chairmen to create multiple releases on how to plan and execute quality and creative fundraisers
- Ensure that fundraising quality is constantly improving by working directly with Regional/Council Gizborim
- Educate Regional/Council Gizborim about the process of developing, organizing, and executing successful fundraisers

COUNTERPARTS, CHAIRMEN & THE INTERNATIONAL BOARD

- Contact regional/council counterparts often, and make myself available to them on a daily basis
- Hold three or four counterpart training sessions throughout the the year via conference calls
- Create monthly releases for Mazkirim, Gizborim, and Sophrim
- Make a Facebook group for all regional/council counterparts and chairmen
- Be in contact with my BBG counterpart on a daily basis
