Throughout YLC the following themes will be incorporated into the weekend's events to help participants develop strong leadership skills. Several of these themes are listed below:

- -BBYO HISTORY: THROUGH TIME- We will go back in time and simulate the early history and development of BBYO through the eyes one of its founder, Sam Beber in 1924. The historical journey will be followed by a discussion which will help participants better understand why we are members of BBYO and what we offer the world at large.
- LEADERSHIP SKILLS: THE KOSHER PIG- Through research, Psychologist have found that people can better understand their leadership style through analysis of their drawings. In this fun activity participants will be given paper and pencil and will then have one minute to draw a picture of a pig. After the minute is up we will then learn how our own individual drawings can reveal hints of information that can help us to build and develop our leadership skills.
- -THE BBYO SHABBAT EXPERIENCE: SWEET SHABBAT- During our Friday night Shabbat dinner we will celebrate with the theme of a "Sweet Shabbat." Our goal will be to highlight and share a "Spirit of Sweetness" theme as we set the mood for a "Sweet YLC Weekend." On the dinner table we will have traditional apples and honey and a little twist of kosher candies to complement our Shabbat dinner.
- -DFFICER ROLES: MOCK CHAPTER- YLC attendees will be taught the different BBYO officer roles and given the chance to run for a position on and become elected to their YLC Chapter Board.
- -PARLIAMENTARY PROCEDURE: MOCK DYSFUNCTIONAL MEETING- This informative and fun program will help the YLC Mock Chapter members to understand just how disorderly a meeting can become when parliamentary procedures are not followed at the chapter meetings. This will be accomplished by assigning each chapter member a unique behavior that will disrupt the mock meeting. The goal of this program is to demonstrate how even small distractions at a meeting combined with a dysfunctional general board will almost always be counter-productive.
- -PRINCIPLES/TRADITIONS: UP YOU MEN- As an AIT it is great to experience the true spirit that BBYO provides. It will be an honor to teach "Up You Men" to YLC attendees so that the AZA pulse will continue to be perpetuated on into the future.
