PROGRAMMING

Goals and Ideas

ELECTIONS/CAUCUSING


Goals and Ideas

- Organize a debate between the Godol candidates before the elections. Questions will be asked and each candidate must answer with the region present, this will be done in debate format.
- Speed up the caucusing process by reducing discussion time of each candidate by one minute. This could decrease the overall time by roughly 15 minutes.
- Reduce the time given to each candidate for speeches and questions by one to two minutes, thus further reducing the length of the caucusing process.
- Strive to make elections stress free for those running, and enjoyable for those observing.
- Collect platforms after the caucusing process and redistribute them during elections on Sunday morning. This way, when the time comes to vote, the platforms are fresh in the minds of the chapters voting.
