 - Fill out call reflection form and share with counterparts after our call to look back on what we discussed
 - Request monthly update on what each chapter has been doing and work they have been accomplishing for me to highlight via social media and in counterpart e-mails
 - Be available at all times as both a counterpart and a friend
- Send out monthly e-mails to all chapter counterparts to keep them internationally connected



- Bring BBYO Connect into synagogues, JCC's, and Jewish summer camps
- Create BBYO introduction programs to bring to potential BBYO communities

- The summer of a lifetime?
- Create application that embodies all qualities of the ideal coordinator
- Ensure that the coordinator process is fair and unbiased
- Make sure that every CFTC session is unique
- Create "How to Recruit for CFTC" guide including videos, calling scripts, and releases
- Create "Parents Guide to CFTC" to help parents better understand the program and the benefits of their teen attending
- Use past participants to get feedback on their CFTC experiences so we can improve the program
- Have more global teens attend CFTC to gain better understanding of the BBYO experience
- Potentially bring CFTC to the West Coast making attending easier for more teens
- Have coordinators have follow-up conference calls with their CFTC participants to stay updated on what they are doing and how they have implemented everything learned at CFTC into their chapters, councils, and regions
- This will influence CFTC participants to attend more summer experiences and international programs

Education and History

- Learning about the times before us?
- Create an International Education and History handbook so all BBGs learn everything they will ever need
- Make a "Welcome to BBG" video for MITs to watch when they join BBYO to feel internationally connected from the very beginning
- Put together resources of successful Education and History programs to be used on the regional and chapter levels
- Create "History of BBG" website where people can input the history of their regions, councils, and chapters so any BBG across the order can access it easily

Membership

- Creating BBYO times for Jewish teens?
- Set attainable goals with each regional and council MIT Mom at the very beginning of their term
- Create a personalized list for each council and region on places they can go to recruit new members
- Start retaining members before their membership expires
- Create senior survey for seniors to fill out about what they want in BBYO their senior year so regional and council boards can keep them involved
- Celebrate EVERY membership accomplishment no matter how big or small it is!
- Create membership tracker that is released monthly to each region showing their growth and percentage to their goal
- Create "Benefits of Becoming a BBYO Member" release to be sent out to engaged teens who have not yet registered for membership
- Put together personalized plan for each region/council to make recruitment as effective as possible
