Drop-In Sports

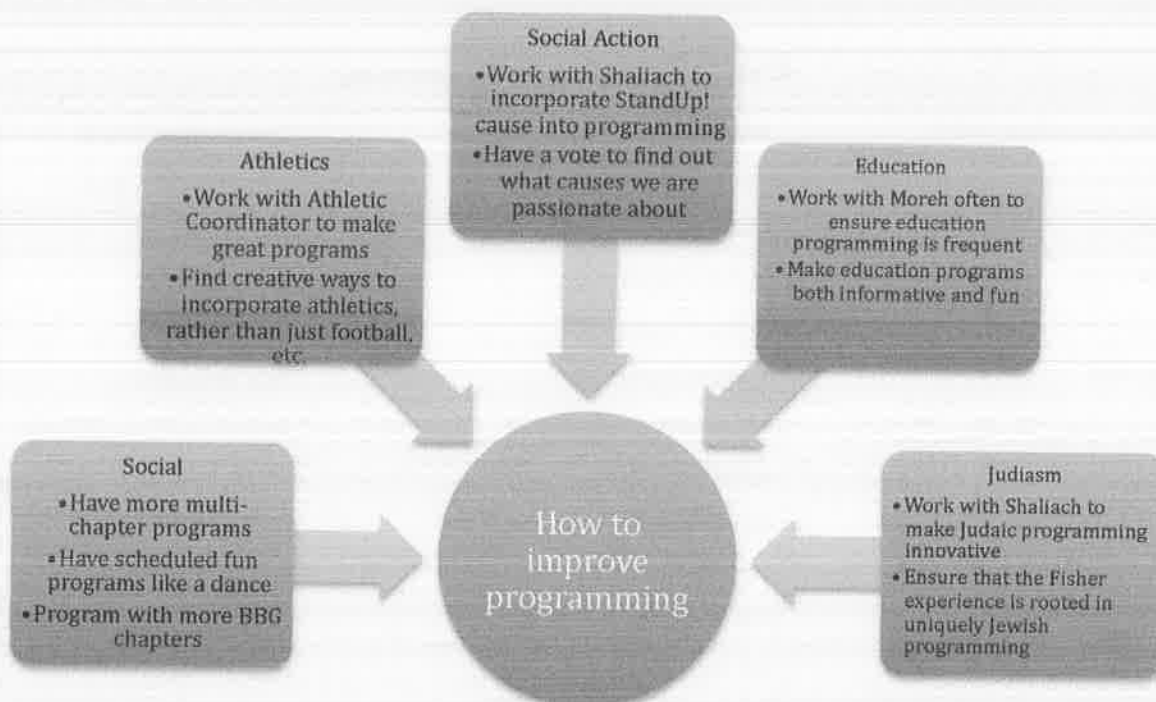
A monthly trip to Drake Park to play sports with year-long teams that will build brotherhood over the year.
