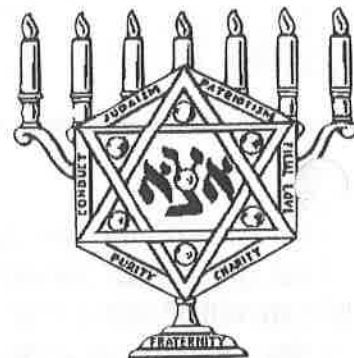

Social

- ✚ For all programs, have them all include some social aspect.
- ✚ Not all programs will entirely be based on social fold, but the programs that are will be with at least one other chapter.
- ✚ Have brotherhood sleepovers to strengthen the chapter internally and become a stronger, closer chapter.
- ✚ Have a function "Who am I" where everyone writes down things about themselves and the rest of the chapter tries to figure out who it is.

Education

- ✚ Educate all chapter members so they know all there is to know about BBYO
- ✚ Have a platform workshop to educate younger members or members running for a position for the first time how to create a platform.
- ✚ Go to a chapter member's house and build a Sukkah, and then fulfill another mitzvah by eating a meal in the Sukkah.

Ideas and Goals for the Position

Programming

- ✿ Have at least one function every weekend, totaling in a minimum of four functions per month.
- ✿ Have two out of every three functions with other chapters.
- ✿ Create a programming ideas section on the fisher website for members to submit ideas for programs easier and more effectively.
- ✿ Have all programs include two+ folds.
- ✿ Publicize all of our functions more effectively through many forms.
- ✿ Have the Katvanim ask their calling list which events they will be attending and report to me, so that we will have a better idea of how many members will be attending each function.
- ✿ Have each function be fun for everyone and have a good feel to it.

Meetings

- ✿ Have 100% attendance at all executive board meetings by setting the date far in advance, so that all executive board members will be able to plan around the meetings.
- ✿ Have executive board meetings run smoothly, and have these meetings be effective and productive.
- ✿ When the Aleph Godol is not present, take over the chapter meetings without any interruption.

AIT's

- ✿ Have all AIT's help plan a function, so as to help them gain experience in this area.
- ✿ Teach the AIT S'gan all about the position
- ✿ Work with the AIT S'gan to plan a separate program.

Counterparts

- ✿ Stay in contact with the regional S'gan and talk to him about programming ideas.
- ✿ Create good relationships and maintain contact with the S'gans and S'ganit of other chapters in the region so that we can successfully function with all other chapters.

Chapter Members

- ✿ Have every function be "sponsored" by a chapter member who would work with me to plan the function, so that all members who are not necessarily on the executive board have a chance to be involved with programming.
- ✿ For each program, provide a choice of programs to the chapter, and have the chapter vote on which one we will have.
- ✿ Have at least 20 members attending each function.

Executive Board

- ✿ Stay in touch with every board member.
- ✿ Godol: Work with the Godol and his needs to keep the chapter running as he sees fit.
- ✿ Moreh: Work with the Aleph Moreh and the AIT Moreh to create the best prospective function possible that will be fun and make the prospectives feel like a part of the chapter.
- ✿ Shaliach: Work with him to plan at least one community service function per month, not including an ongoing project.
- ✿ Gizbor: Plan an executive board meeting designed around passing the budget.
- ✿ Mazkir: Plan a program with the Mazkir to promote summer programs in a new format.
- ✿ Sopher: Work with Sopher to plan a function that includes a time designated for writing articles for the newspaper.


Other Responsibilities
