Goals for the 2009-2010 Programming Year

- ❖ Make a calendar of events available for the chapter online and on paper
- ❖ Use b-linked for programs more often so we can give out more information
- ❖ Work with the Gizbor to have one or more fundraisers at the beginning of the year to subsidize the cost of programs
- ❖ Have an Executive Board sleepover(s) in addition to chapter sleepovers throughout the year in order to create strong bonds throughout the board and the chapter
- ❖ Begin advertising for events earlier than before
- ❖ Always have a back-up plan for my programs
- ❖ Utilize the program bank and put my programs in it
- ❖ Make sure that all necessary information about events is available to the chapter
- ❖ Plan at least three functions every month
- ❖ Have 3 out of every 5 functions be with girls, and 2 with guys
- ❖ Push for more programs with multiple chapters
- ❖ Function with every chapter at least once throughout the programming year
