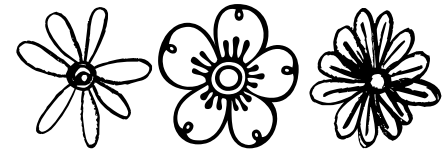


My Sisters B'nai B'rith Girls,

• Programming Excellence

- Have Monthly Regional Calls for S'ganitot and anyone else interested in programming to discuss programming around the region, and how to work to improve our programming as a region
- Have a Leadership Training Institute Session for all chapter S'ganitot

- Have at least 330 attendees at Regionals 2014
- Create a Spring Committee that works to help find organizations to partner with in addition to other guests for Regionals
- Create a Regional Push Week for registration with the help of chapter N'siot
- Have each BBG chapter send at least 20 members to Regionals 2014
- Have BBGG while AZAA is occurring

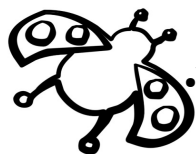
