## Membership:

**Albert Einstein Academy:** This school is crucial to our recruitment. It contains many Jews who are proud to be Jewish and would love to join AZA. We need to harvest this recruitment tool and recruit here. This will help with my plan for 15 members by January 15<sup>th</sup> and the International Membership Mile.

**Temple Beth Ami and Services:** Temple Beth Ami is another tool for the success of RD. We are very close to having accepted us and have it as a meeting spot. I have been working with Steven Molberger that way we have an extra connection to push forward our chapter.

**Prospective List:** We currently have a list of 40 Jews in BBYO. We obviously know who the Jews are and that they are friends so we should easily be able to bring 15 by the 15<sup>th</sup> and at least 20 by the end of the term (2 a month with the Double plan as well).

**Double Plan/ 15 by the 15th:** The Double plan refers to every member in the chapter to bring in a member. If this occurs, we can easily have 15 members committed by January 15<sup>th</sup>.

**International Membership Mile: Recruit over 20 members** by following International Membership Mile by having specific events for perspectives containing the best part of BBYO. Retain at least 90% of membership while getting back members that have left in previous terms.

## Programming:

**5 Fold Rotational System:**  
Every week the Folds will be incorporated into programming. For example, every first program of the month will have Athletic programming. The next program or meeting if there is none will be Community Service based. If they are five weeks in a specific month, we will have a 5-folded event.

**WOW programs:** WOW programs are community wide events that incorporate AZA ideals into community life. We need to work a WOW program to help our reputation and leave a big impression on Santa Clarita for the better.

**Branch Out:** My plan for programming is to branch out to other BBG chapters and AZA chapters. This will help us by showing how great RD is and will make sure RD has time to meet the BBGs of the region.

**CHAMPS:** CHAMPS is PCR's new initiative to put innovation into programming. I want to make sure will work to incorporate the CHAMPS theme to make the program more fun as well as help us gain respect from the region.

## Fraternity and Traditions:

### Fraternity and Traditions:
