Mid-Michigan

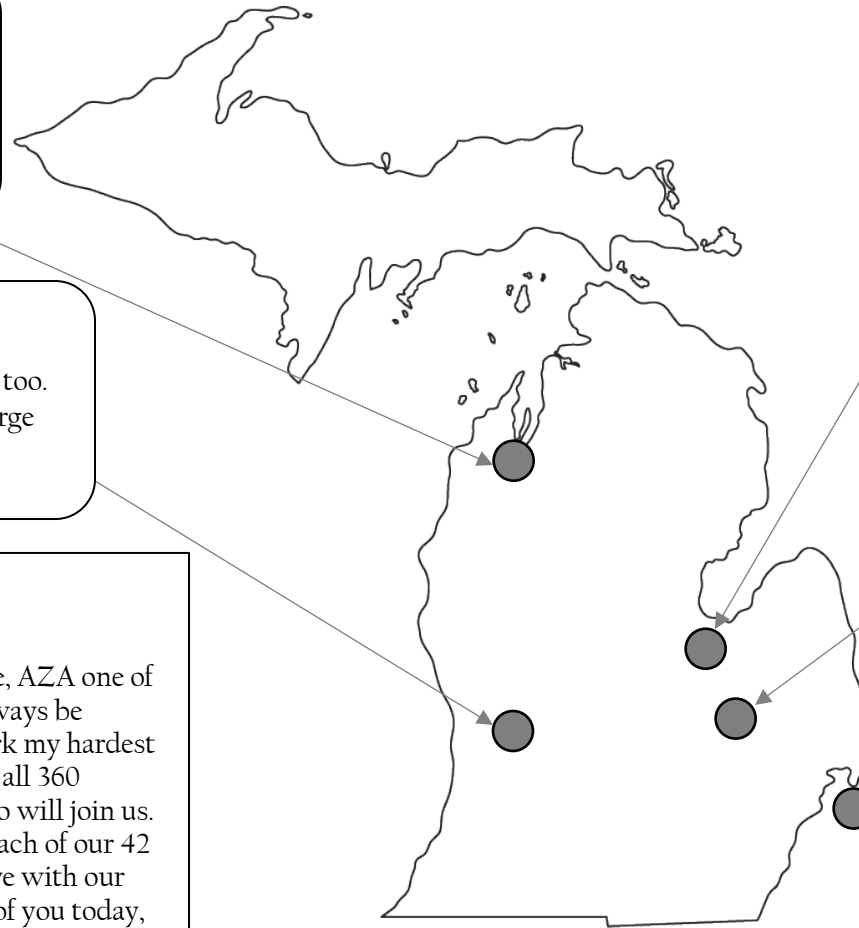
