- Continue the programming excellence policy, ensuring that each event is posted on dashboard at least two weeks before it occurs.

## **IDEAS FOR THE FUTURE:**

- Online Templates and folders to store programs on Google drive to allow easy access by the regional board and other S'ganim around the region.
- Have a **Public Calendar** so all the other S'ganim can see what is happening around the region and what other chapters are up to.
- Work with each chapter to help establish **Programming**Committees, allowing general members to be involved with
  creating and running programs. This can get people hooked on
  BBYO, who otherwise, wouldn't have considered it.
- Work with the Moreh to create the Brother Planning Program, a system where seniors are paired with AITs and are put in charge of planning one chapter fold. This system can engage newer members with the chance to program with an older member, and give the older member a spark to keep them from burning out.
- Work with the Maz/Giz to create a Summer Program Showcase, where each city will have events showing off summer programs. This will include testimonies and a summer program 'simulation.' This will help people understand what summer programs can teach you, as many newer members are uninformed on the wonderful programming that happens during summer programs.
- Create the **Programming Cup**, an award given out at every regional event for the best single all around program, submitted beforehand in an application style submission (This will help S'gan be prepared for Program of the Year applications).
