Stand Up and Social Action

- Plan an event pairing with Keen, working with kids with special needs
 - Participate in physical activities with the kids, such as soccer and basketball
- Collaborate with Gizborit to make a Standup! wearable
- Coordinate speakers associated with our Standup! cause
- Plan at least two Standup! programs and fundraisers
- Introduce chapter to charity walks and runs to support members of our chapter

Speak Up for Israel

- Plan a Shark Tank program introducing innovations established in Israel
 - Members design inventions and showcase to judges
 - Inform members about inventions created in Israel
- Send out Hwow once a week and do a Kahoot quiz at a meeting the end of each month
- Have an Israeli themed meeting
 - Encourage members to bring Israeli food and share Israeli music
- Provide updates on current events in Israel during meetings and programs

Havdalah & Song Sessions

- Choose Middah of the month
 - Every month one person from each grade who exemplifies middah (friendship) is chosen to hold their candle during Havdalah
- Utilize the five Havdalah candles made by each grade from last term
- Help to increase energy and enthusiasm during song sessions
- Read out quotes during Havdalah that relate to the program
- Update the chapter on recent information about the Standup! cause

Shabbat

- Bring in speakers for Shabbats relating to Standup! cause
- Plan a Shabbat at least once a month
 - Allow chapter to request themes for certain Shabbatot
- Plan Shul of the months with other chapters
- Utilize the song books at Shabbats
- Explore different ways of celebrating Shabbat
 - Introduce song sessions, meditation, etc.
- Hold a Parent-Teen Shabbat to inform parents about BBYO
- Plan grade Shabbat dinners
 - Choose one planner from each grade

Jewish Heritage & Holidays

- Plan a Rosh Hashanah apple-picking trip
- Work with S'ganit to incorporate Jewish holidays into programs
- Incorporate Tashlikh into a program for Rosh Hashanah
- **Help to Plan Sukkot Sleepover**
 - Make it a meaningful sisterhood event with creative programming and activities
- Create Jewish identity masks at the beginning of term
