THE GAME PLAN:

GODOL

- Have weekly calls with all board member, to make sure everyone is on the same page
- Maintain organization by having a digital calendar for all events and meetings
- Have a strong bond with board members by motivating them to do great through incentives
- Keep an open mind to all members, and to take in new ideas that will better the chapter
- Create bonding opportunities with board members as well as general members with the end goal to have a unified chapter

S'GAN

- Make sure the S'gan incorporates at least 2 of the 5 folds in every chapter program
- Train the S'gan to run the chapter meeting in case the Godol is not present
- Help the S'gan to put all events are on the BBYO website to make sure the regional staff knows about them
- Have the S'gan create a committee so he gets more help planning programs as well as giving more members leadership opportunities
- Aid the Moreh in creating an ALT board by the end of January
- Have the Moreh create a recruitment committee that is made up of 2 Alephs, so that much effort is put into growing the chapter
- Help the Moreh in checking that older members come back to events through texting and face-to-face contact

MOREH

- Restabilize the chapter bank account by having at least 3 major fundraisers in the upcoming year
- Assist the Gizbor in planning the most successful and creative fundraisers possible with different restaurants and new ideas
- Check that the Gizbor has access to bank account at all times, so the chapter will have necessary funds when needed
- Make sure there is money for chapter members if they ever need financial assistance to attend chapter events
- Help the Gizbor with reimbursing chapter parents for all the money put-out for events

GIZBOR

- Help the Moreh in educating the whole chapter with creative ways of doing so, such as creating BBYO-themed board games
- Make sure that the Moreh has a strong relationship with the regional staff and counterparts
- Through weekly phone calls, making sure the Shaliach is planning community service programs
- Assist the Shaliach in reaching out to places where Fisher can volunteer
- Make sure the Shaliach plans at least 1 service and/or Judaic program every other month
- Have the Shaliach work with a chapter member so he can have help planning his events, as well as making sure the S'gan is present to help as needed

SHALIACH

- Have the Mazkir create eye catching posters for all events
- Make sure the Mazkir is posting on the Fisher Instagram for every event/fundraiser
- Create a Remind 101 with the Mazkir to let members know about upcoming events, which will increase chapter communication
- Work with the Mazkir and S'gan to plan a summer programs night to encourage younger Fishermen to attend one
- Have the Mazkir take notes at chapter meetings in order for the members who did not attend the meetings to still know what went on
- Have the Sopher create the most fly RC shirt in order to have a repeat of first place
- Create a newspaper committee so the Sopher would not need to design newspaper by himself
- Aid the Sopher in creating 3 new spirit wear items during the next year
- Encourage the Sopher to talk with chapter alumni to get good advice on making a great newspaper as well as to creating exciting spirit wear
- Create a calendar with the RC coordinator to let the chapter members know dates of practices
- Starting 3 months prior to RC, have weekly calls with the coordinator to help plan the convention
- Help the RC coordinator in planning the big 3, along with the help of the S'gan
- Set tangible goals for the RC coordinator to guide him on the path of success
