Goals and Ideas

Recruitment

- Create initiatives with the board members to encourage all members to recruit MITs (whoever recruits the most MITs at the end of the term will win a candle at the last meeting of the term)
- Continue to keep track of perspective members and assign each board member 2-3 perspective members to keep updated on what events are coming up (like big/little sis for perspective members)
- Have a short icebreaker at the beginning of each program/event to make every MIT/perspective member feel welcome

Connect

- Have two connect events in the term with fun and engaging programs for the perspective members to fall in love with BBYO
- Work with the Connect Chair to plan ways to spread the word about BBYO (speaking at Jewish Day Schools/synagogues, etc.)
- Make sure perspective members are getting the information about meetings if they are not in the Facebook group (Facebook messenger, text, etc.)
- Encourage members to disperse at connect events so perspective members are not alone

Sisterhood

- Continue to uphold and encourage the Big/Little Sis program (hold Big/Little Sis programs specifically planned for assigned sisters to bond)
- Plan sisterhood sleepovers dedicated to sisterhood programming, MBA, etc.
- Build chapter traditions to bond all of our members together (ex: icebreakers at every meeting/program, etc.)
- Plan fun MBA programs after more serious programs as a way to get perspective members to come back and get to know other members

Retention

- Utilize the Big/Little Sis program as a way for the little sisters to gather information about upcoming events/meetings/programs
- Divide MITs up among big sisters at conventions so the MITs feel included and welcome at conventions (big sisters can introduce MITs to regional friends and integrate our MITs into our region)
- Uphold the chair position program in order to give newer members more leadership opportunities

Re-education

- Hold MIT classes and utilize a MIT handbook so MITs are less confused on what goes on in BBYO
- Uphold a MIT Facebook group or group chat for me to answer any questions/concerns the MITs might have
