

## Recruitment and MITs

- Keep MIT Board active
- Recruit at least 5 new non-8<sup>th</sup> grade members before Spring Term
- Begin speaking in Sunday School classes by December
- Work with Mazkirah to create a recruitment video
- Start compiling lists of 8<sup>th</sup> Graders' names and phone numbers in the fall
- Rewards for members who bring a friend who is eligible to join the chapter to meetings

## Increasing Sisterhood

- Increased number of chapter events outside of meetings
  - ie: sleepovers, day trips, etc
- Big/Little sis program
  - Pair an upperclassman with a younger member
- Good-and-Welfare programs in new formats (ex: "Ask Amy" -write letters with questions to other BBG's and get them answered, "Step In" - everyone's in a circle, someone reads a series of statements, members step in if they apply to them) as a chance to grow closer

## Current Members and Retention

- Upperclassman appreciation programs
- Create an Aliah phone book so that members can contact others who live near them in order to get to meetings more easily
- Work with Mazkirah to contact members who haven't attended events in a while
- Create more leadership opportunities (ie: chairs, programming opportunities) so that all members feel involved and are given equal opportunity to contribute to the chapter

## Re-education

- Include at least 2-3 folds in each program
- Hold 2-3 official business meetings during the Fall term in order to keep the chapter familiar with the procedures
- BBG Re-Education Jeopardy
  - Members have to answer BBG trivia
- Hold a re-education sleep over similar to the MIT sleep over in which members get to re-learn BBG basics and refresh their memories.
