Optimizing the Visit

Before:

- 1. Send out survey form 2 weeks prior to visit
 - a. RAG/CAG \rightarrow 3 goals, 2 problems, 1 highlight
 - b. R/C-Board→ Write about the status of the region with their respective position in mind (including their work with their counterparts)
 - c. Chapter Godols → 1 problem, 1 highlight, and a list of active general members who are <u>not</u> on board
- 2. Go through responses with Grand Board
- Do research about the local Jewish community and organizations
- Set meetings with staff, regional/council board, chapter boards, and the collective group of active general members

During:

- 5. Attend meetings with R/C-Board to talk through priorities, issues, and highlights, as well as set goals for moving forward
- 6. Talk to the group of active general members to ensure that the voices of AZA base are heard and see how we can better support them
- 7. Get to know and hang out with as many Alephs as possible
- 8. Meet with local Jewish organizations to help build partnerships and look for areas of potential for regional/council expansion

After:

PATRIOTISM & JUDAISM & FILIAL LOVE & CHARITY & CONDUCT & PURITY & FRATERNITY

- 9. Discuss with the Grand Board how to better support the individual region/council and chapters based off of takeaways
- Follow up 2-4 weeks later to see how the region/council and chapters are progressing on their goals
- 11. Set new goals and give further advice and support

Focus Groups:

(applying an ILN-type structure)

- These focus groups would more effectively channel the strength of our Order into our 5 priorities (Grow AZA & BBG, Program Excellence, BBYO Stand UP, BBYO Goes Global, and BBYO Speak Up)
- Every Regional/Council Godol will submit a form listing the top three priorities that they're most passionate about
- Each focus group would be overseen by a member of the group who applies for that position to the International Board
- The ties formed in these focus groups would encourage interregional bonding between regional/council presidents that might also translate into more interregional programming and communication

Globalization

A Worldwide Organization:

- N Anti-Semitism and assimilation weakens the body of world Jewry and so it is more important than ever that we look out for our brothers outside of North America
- N To build stronger bonds we must first better understand what their communities are like
 - ➡ I will work with the GNC to select Alephs from around the world and ask them to write about what their lives are like in their local communities
 - Each month, we will send their stories out to the Order to highlight what world Jewry in more distant areas is like

ISF:

- ম ISF push week

 - Raise Money (International and local raffles, donation campaign, chapter fundraisers with prizes)
- M Implement text-to-give system similar to that used by the International Red Cross

A Grassroots Focus

(We serve YOU, not the other way around)

Communication:

- Especially important are those voices of the AZA base not commonly heard because they do not hold board positions
 - ★ Talk to groups of active general members who are <u>not</u> on board during regional/council visits
- K Create a portal that would allow any member to submit questions, comments, or concerns about their chapters, regions, or AZA in general

Individualized Plans:

Work with Grand Board to create individualized recruitment and programming plans with every region/council

Follow-Up:

- Be sure to follow up with every region/council about their individualized plans
- R Follow up with portal comments
