Goals

- 🕒 At the beginning of term meet with each chapter's Godol and Gizbor to create detailed term long budget sheets and fundraiser calendars based on each chapter's current standing.
- 🕒 At the beginning of term have meeting with each chapter's Godol and Gizbor to set the chapter's fundraiser per month goal alongside general fundraising and I\$F Fundraising goals for each month and also the entire term.
- 🕒 Work with the council Mazkir to enhance the Spring AZAA Tournament and also raise more money through shuk by adding more products people want to buy.
- 🕒 Raise a record amount of money for I\$F and Council Stand Up to bring even more Bulgarians to IC, ILTC, and Kallah
- 🕒 Work with BBG Counterpart to make the best D.C. Council apparel to sell at conventions.
- 🕒 Release RC shuk catalog at least 3 weeks before.
- 🕒 Plan at least 3 council wide fundraisers a term to raise money for scholarships, I\$F, StandUp, and for other council needs.
- 🕒 Have weekly calls with each counterpart individually and have meetings with the entire "Gizbor Team" at the beginning of each month to assure that everyone is on the same page and following their goals and budget.
- 🕒 Strive to reply to all e-mails and calls within 24 hours to keep our Council moving.
- 🕒 Send out weekly emails to all counterparts for the week ahead.
- 🕒 Work with BBG Counterpart to create and update the official D.C. Council fundraiser calendar and to ensure that chapters do not have conflicting fundraisers.

Ideas

- 🕒 4-Week Plan: Based off of the successful 5-week S'gan
- 🕒 Programming plan the 4-week plan enhance every fundraiser raising more money, increase communication between Council Gizbor and counterparts, and further legitimize the position of Gizbor. Look at the column on the right to learn more about the 4-week plan.
- 🕒 Create an official D.C. Council fundraiser calendar where all fundraisers are shown and people can see information about each fundraiser, this way, everyone can keep track of fundraisers.
- 🕒 Create an online D.C. Council Fundraiser resource bank similar to the international programming bank to emphasize large-scale fundraisers.
- 🕒 Have big council fundraisers planned by members from around D.C. Council. Instead of having the Council Gizbor and Gizborit singlehandedly plan fundraisers, for each large fundraiser have "coordinator applications" similar to convention steerers who will work with the Council Gizbor and Gizborit to plan and execute the fundraiser getting the council money while giving the applicants noteworthy experience.
- 🕒 At the beginning of the term have a workshop for Gizbors and Gizborits from around the council teaching them in depth about every single aspect of serving the position.
- 🕒 At the beginning of term have a meeting with each chapter's Godol and Gizbor and set a minimum fundraiser per month goal tailored on their current standing. Each chapter must meet that goal each month.
- 🕒 Create a Gizbor of the month award to be given out at each council meeting to serve as incentives for Gizbors.
- 🕒 Get D.C. Council and each individual chapter sponsored by a local organization.
- 🕒 Plan fundraiser specifically for BBYO Bulgaria to get even more Bulgarian teens at IC, ILTC, and Kallah.
- 🕒 Encourage chapters to apply for the BBYO Partnership program.

🕒 4-Weeks Before 🕒

Council Gizbor and Chapter Godol are notified of the fundraiser idea and the desired location for the fundraiser is contacted. The Basic Information form is filled out which includes day and time of fundraiser, location of fundraiser, where the money is going, attendance and profit goal, event organizers, and summary of event. After being submitted the event is put on the official D.C. Council fundraiser calendar.

🕒 2-Weeks Before 🕒

If the fundraiser is a large scale program-like event, ex. Carnival or sports tournament, the official "Chapter Program Planning Template" must be filled out and a meeting must be conducted between the council Gizbor and the chapter Gizbor & Godol. Facebook event is made and advertising begins through flyers and social media for all fundraisers.

🕒 1-Week Before 🕒

Flyers are distributed during Monday meetings, full force advertising begins, and if necessary supplies are bought.
