- Profits from sales go to Fisher and Stand Up cause.

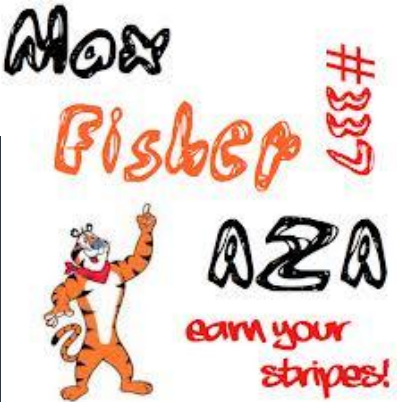

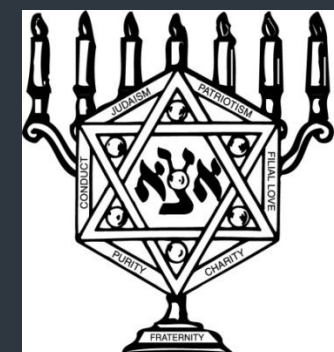


BBYO IMPACT BOSTON
