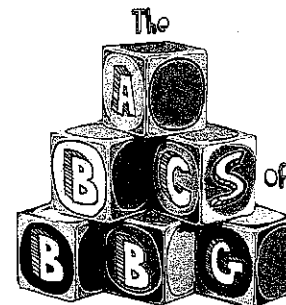

Education

- Hold an informative parent meeting with n'siah

- Teach MITs about programming by helping them plan a multi-fold function for the entire chapter.

- Send as many MITs as possible to YLC and CLTC

Recruitment

- Organize a committee of older members responsible for calling and checking in on prospective members.
- Create fliers with upcoming events to pass out to prospective members.
- Design a fun and enticing booth portraying the chapter at Spring Kickoff.
- Make sure programs during recruitment season are very creative and fun.
- Encourage members to give me the numbers of any potential members they may know.

Senior Appreciation

- Hold a Senior Tribute Night – a reverse Senior Lives where members make show the seniors how much they have done for the chapter
- Create personalized momento books for each senior with messages from chapter members.
- Hold a senior sleepover.
- Organize a meaningful Senior Lives ceremony.

Advisor Appreciation

- Have the chapter make a gift showing our appreciation.
- Work with the Orechot to dedicate a page in the scrapbook to our wonderful advisor.

Retention/Sisterhood

- Create a Big Sister/Little Sister program, and encourage older members to regularly check up on their little sisters.
- Hold meaningful separates programs at chapter sleepovers and Bittkers to inspire members.
- Personally call inactive members encouraging them to attend events.
- Work with the N'siah and Katvanit to enforce the 30-day policy.
- Hold class sleepovers so members can bond with their grades.
- Create a perfect balance of "chill" and inspirational programming.
