Goals/Ideas



- Increasing communication amongst the chapter and the board.
 - Periodic 1-on-1 calls with board members to facilitate close board relationships, to keep everyone on schedule, and to make sure all board responsibilities are completed.
 - Notifications going out in the first half of the week.
 - Notifications detailing the upcoming two weeks.
 - Chapter wide calendar featuring multiple months.
- Increasing chapter programming amount and chapter programming variety.
 - Different types of programs will allow Reisbord events to appeal to a wider audience.
- Further developing mutual respect amongst Alephs.
 - A more inclusive and friendly Randy Reisbord AZA will develop, and all will feel more welcome.
- The Godol being involved in many parts of the board and acting as a liaison.
 - Being involved in many board functions will help keep the Godol informed on the board's progress.
 - Intra-board communication will be increased.
- Regularly occurring chapter meetings.

- Increasing social action – Community Service/Stand Up and Israeli Advocacy/Speak Up.
 - A long-lasting relationship with an organization to provide a recurring service project for those interested.
 - More social action in projects.
- Close communication between the board, the Advisors, and our regional counterparts.
