SOCIAL

ATHLETIC

COMMUNITY SERVICE

I will work closely with the Regional Shaliach in planning J-Serve as well as adding a regional community service day separate from J-Serve near the beginning of the year.

EDUCATION

I will work with the Regional Moreh on the emerging leaders committee as well as creating a regional "BBYOathon" in which younger alephs can learn about BBYO history and traditions all while having fun at the same time.

GOALS
