## Board Communication

- ☁ Have board meetings at least 2 times a month

Chairs

- ☁ Have chair application sent out the week after kidnap
- ☁ Have 3 chair meetings

- ☁ Oversee chair responsibilities

Council

## Organization

## Program Schedule

- ☁ Sign up sheet to plan programs
- ✳ give out at kidnap, and send with first comms email

- ☁ Outline completed and sent in 3 weeks before date
- ✳ Have outlines created/put on google docs for easy access with the planners and the s'garim
- ☁ Edit outline with co 2 ½ weeks before date
- ☁ Send outline to council 2 weeks before date
- ☁ Have materials 1 ½ weeks before date
- ☁ Final edit 1 week before
- ☁ Finalization of entire program with planners the Wednesday before date

## Programming

- ☁ Give everyone a chance to plan programs
- ☁ Get seniors involved with planning
- ☁ 2-3 brotherhoods/sisterhoods
- ☁ Have two 6-8, 8-10 programs
- ☁ All programs are 3<sup>rd</sup> degree
  - ✳ Excellent/Exemplary
- ☁ Create step-by-step "How to Make an Outline" for first time planners
  - ✳ A model of an outline
- ☁ Have 1-2 programs with another chapter in D.C. Council
- ☁ Put the best/most successful programs on program bank
- ☁ Evaluate programs with co and Godd/Nsiah to see what needs improvement and what should stay the same
- ☁ Put programs on dashboard 1-2 weeks in advance
- ☁ Have 2-3 out of the basement programs
