# Goals & Ideas

**Create a Unified S'ganit Network:** Create a Facebook group, contact information packet, and advice packet for all of my counterparts to help each other reach their highest potential and fulfill their goals!

**Programming Polls:** Email out a survey to all counterparts in order to assess their region/council's strengths and weaknesses. Based on these results:

**S'ganit Circles** will be created. Each circle will consist of S'ganit with regions/councils that resemble each other. Groups will work together to address common issues and brainstorm strategic plans to better their regions, councils, and chapters.

**Global Impact Programming:** Within the S'ganit Circles, a StandUp! cause will be chosen to have sisters internationally helping one another to make a difference in the world.

**Chapter Challenges:** To keep chapter counterparts involved internationally, create new opportunities, such as initiatives and contests, for the chapter S'ganit to challenge one another and shine in areas which they excel.

**Programming Committees:** More Jewish Teens, More Meaningful Jewish Experiences. By having more members participate in the programming process, our Order can improve its programming and increase leadership through delegating duties.

**Program Bank Chairs:** Encourage members to upload programs to share what each chapter and region is doing to further our movement.

**Overseas Programming:** Keep in contact with International and Overseas communities and share how our sisters and brothers from other countries program.

**International Sisterhood Chair:** Bring back MBA and traditions that the B'nai B'rith Girls have continued for almost 67 years.

**Teamwork:** Work together to meet all deadlines and reach all goals.

**Conduct:** Be a role model to all members of our Order by leading with respect.

**Promotion:** Encourage all members to take part in the many opportunities, such as Summer Experiences, contests, initiatives, and everything that BBYO has to offer!

**Program of the Month:** Every month a program from the Bank will be sent out to the Order to promote innovative and creative programming!

**Degrees of Programming:** Incorporate the Degrees of Programming in the Program Bank standards to inform and educate members about the many programming levels.

**Promotion:** Create "How to" videos and Prezis to make uploading easier.

**Organization:** Continue to reorganize the Bank for easy access to convention planning, chapter programs, icebreakers, inductions, SpeakUp! promotion, etc.

**Programming Hub:** My dashboard page will be the go-to place for all programming questions and concerns.

**Resource Central:** Compile a collection of resources from individual counterparts and chairs to give everyone and anyone the information she needs to excel in programming!

**Silly S'ganit Sites:** Random websites, videos, speakers, and news that may help spark ideas around the Order.

**IC Steering:** Release applications and announce the committee as early as possible to ensure steers have an ample amount of time to brainstorm, to organize, and to perfect programs.

**Spirit Days:** Announce spirit days at least two months in advance to provide regions with more time to organize spirit gear.

**IC Involvement:** Create many new opportunities for members of our Order to get involved in the IC planning process. (Ex. Elective Programs, Promotional Videos, Contests, etc.)

**Hands On Action:** Host a meaningful, educational, and thoughtprovoking community service event for every teen participating in order to inspire our sisters and brothers to take a stand in their communities.

**IC Blog:** By uploading programs, videos, pictures, mid-state speeches, motions and minutes to the IC Blog, members of our Order that are not attending IC can still feel connected and in the know.

**International States:** Plan a memorable and meaningful States ceremony for the 67th International N'siah of the B'nai B'rith Girls. Also, live-stream and record the ceremony to post on the IC Blog.
