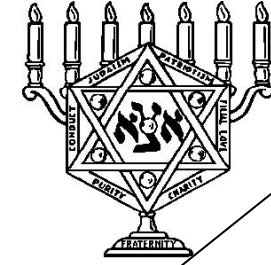

Sustain the Present

SpeakUP has the potential to make an incredible impact. If elected I will launch **Global BBYO campaigns**, to insure that our movement can make a difference to the entire world. SpeakUP should be away of standing up against what is wrong in the world and having our voices heard. To create the greatest effect **I will implement one large campaign for the entire order** to last for that year and then every year the main campaign will change, but the structure implemented in each region/ council/ nation will be the same. **Imagine every Aleph on the Planet all Speaking up** for the Jewish Ethiopians who are still fighting to make Aliyah, then the next year against the farmers from the Ivory Coast who use child slaves on their cocoa farms and then the year after that a campaign against terrorism. Build For the Future

The **StandUP** website BBYO has is the most phenomenal way our order can commit to Tikkun Olam. However the community service hours performed is nowhere near our potential. The Jewish People in the past have always needed help from other nations, but now it's our turn to help others. For everything that is bad in the world, there is a cause that can be made to eliminate it. If elected I will introduce the **StandUP Award Scheme** to give Alephs and BBG's an incentive to want to help build the world for the future. There will be a Bronze Award given to the causes that gain 50 hours of commitment and a cause with 100 hours earns a Silver Award, with StandUP pins presented to those involved on IC. There will not be a Gold Award, similar to the International Award Scheme, however **the most outstanding cause set up will become a StandUP charity**; which will be presented by the founders of the cause on IC and will be one of the causes Alephs volunteer for on the IC Day of Service.
