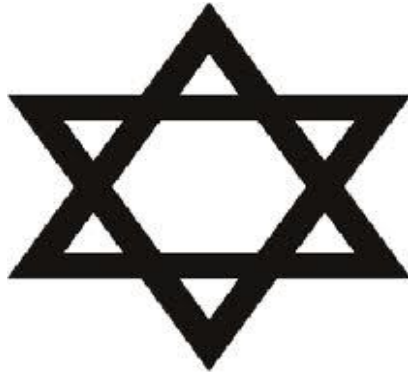
Achievements
