Community Service 🤝

- Increase participation in J-Serve on a regional level through constant advertising and incentives for chapters with high attendance
 - Be on the J-Serve planning committee and attend meetings
- Have the chapter Nsiah and Shlichah set community service goals at the beginning of the programming year
- Encourage each chapter to meet or exceed their RC Community Service requirements
- Inform the region of new community service opportunities through emails, texts, social media, or other methods of communication

Jewish Heritage ⬡

- Create a prayer book with instructions for each chapter to ensure proper services occurring at designated programs and events
- Provide each chapter with a Havdallah kit if they do not have one already
- Supply chapters with a "Blessing Blueprint" for food and drinks, holidays, etc.
- Encourage each chapter to host at least one Jewish holiday program during the year and attend these events whenever possible
- Incorporate aspects of Social Action and Community Service in addition to Jewish Heritage at Regional Kallah
- Hold a regional Shabbat Dinner at least once during the year
- Lead services at respective Regional conventions or events

Social Action 🗣️

- Educate the region on prevalent issues occurring in Metro Detroit, Michigan, America, and Israel during Regional Meetings
- Make sure chapters are incorporating SpeakUp! ideas into their programming and educating their chapters about Israel

StandUp 👤

- Make sure all chapters have their Stand UP cause chosen by September and assist them with choosing one they are passionate about
- Constantly promote and advocate for the regional cause
 - Work with the Regional Gizborit to hold multiple fundraisers throughout the year
 - Invite a representative from a partner organization to come speak to the region
- Hold a Stand UP week to advocate for our cause

- Communicate effectively with the board through any means necessary
