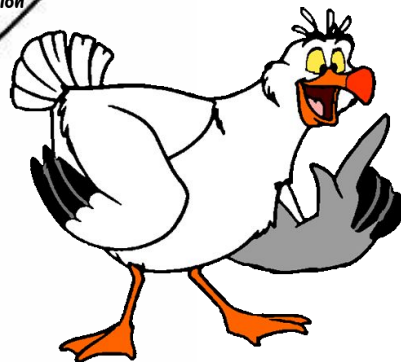

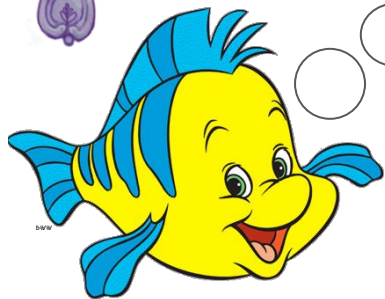
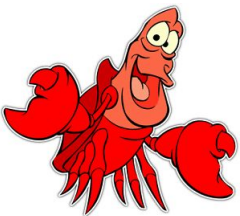

## Counterparts

- ★ Have monthly calls/check ins to keep up with new member progress
- ★ Always be available for questions, concerns, and any other issues

## Recruitment and Sisterhood
