

Goals and Ideas

Jewish Heritage

- Work to incorporate a “Jewish twist” into every program/event
- Jewish heritage game show competition at Invite
- Guide committees to plan services at conventions
 - Help committees stick to a schedule so the services are fully planned in advanced and can run smoothly
 - Create “how to” guides for service planning
 - Push committees to think outside of the box and plan creative services at conventions
 - Make sure there are a variety of types of services offered
- Incorporate sisterhood aspect into Global Shabbat (BBG/AZA Shabbat dinner to remember the roots of our sisterhood/brotherhood on a regional level)
- Teach Birkat Hamazon at the beginning of each convention
- Post updates in the GMR Facebook group about what is going on in Israel and how to help
- Plan at least one Jewish Heritage program at each convention

Counterparts

- Push chapter Sh'lichim to plan a shabbat dinner at least once per term
 - I will attend at least one shabbat dinner hosted by each BBG chapter
- Create a Sh'licha Google Drive folder with resources
 - “How To” guide for planning services/havdalah
 - List of ideas/inspiration for how to incorporate Judaism/Israel into every program/meeting (Parsha explanations, Israel updates, 60 seconds of Israel/Judaism, etc.)
- Bi-monthly emails with updates on what is going on in Israel, explaining the Parsha of the week (+ the following week), and counterpart check-ins (Google Forms)
- I will always be reachable and responsive
- Monthly counterpart calls
- Plan a Judaic program with all of the Sh'lichim to bring back to each chapter
- Create short Google Slideshows about Israel and Judaism for Sh'lichim to use at chapter programs
 - fun facts, updates, Parashot, etc.

Community Service

- Encourage chapters to plan hands on community service events on a consistent basis (ex: first Monday every month)
- Work closely with regional Sh'liach to organize region wide days of community service
- Chapter competition for community service hours throughout the year
 - In addition to Invite competition
 - Chapter with the most hours wins an award
- No specific chapter StandUP cause for more flexibility of service
- Vote on a regional StandUP cause during leadership training day
- Provide information (via GMR Facebook group and new GMR Sh'lichim Twitter account) about community service opportunities
- Encourage SPA Programs (Service, Philanthropy, Advocacy)
 - Create resources for counterparts to come up with SPA ideas
- Promote new StandUP summer programs
- Create a tool to track service hours

Social Action

- Create a GMR Sh'lichim Twitter account to post Israel updates and Sh'lichim related information
- Encourage GMR to research conflicts in Israel in order to be fully informed
- Have at least one SpeakUP elective option at each convention
 - Teach about how Israel has impacted the world (technology, etc.)
- Build connections with educators who advocate for the causes we care about
 - Invite them to conventions
 - Introduce them to chapter Sh'lichim and encourage speakers at chapter events
 - Utilize social media to spread the word about what we learn from the speakers
- Incorporate regional StandUP cause into convention programming
- Encourage chapters to participate in international initiatives

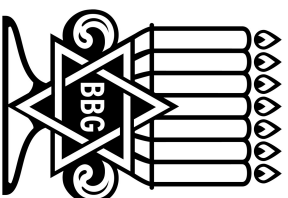
