Conventions:

- ✓ Work closely with Steering Committee's to produce meaningful programs
- ✓ Create programs to unite the convention body
- ✓ Ask participants what programs they would like to see in a survey
- ✓ Aim to have 3 three conventions per year
- ✓ Keep the tradition of Winter Convention with NY regions
- ✓ Convention Coordinators assisted by the regional S'ganim
- ✓ Get at least 50 members to convention
- ✓ Always include fundraisers and shuk
- ✓ Include meaningful themes that relate to the region

Programming:

- ★ Make programs deeper than ever before
- ★ Create programming tip emails to all chapter boards/chairs once a month
- ★ Acknowledge a BBG once a month for her programming commitment and dedication to the region
- ★ At least one chapter program dedicated to summer programs
- ★ Two regional pre IC info session (one in September before IC launch and one in February)
- ★ BBG regional events at least 2-3 times a term
- ★ Grade member dinners
- ★ Host parent info night lead by the regional director and board
- ★ Initiate fold of the month
- ★ Send out emails and discuss with chapter boards on how they will incorporate folds
- ★ Have a regional event at least once a month
- ★ Leave each participant with the "BBG feeling"
- ★ Make sure programs are being submitted at least one week before
- ★ Make sure BBG chapters are having meetings with brother chapters at least once every other month
- ★ Help chapters get out of Jewish institutions and find cool locations for meetings
- ★ Promote extensive use of International program bank
- ★ Get programming feedback from chapter leaders and participants after meetings
