


"when I think of home, I think of a place where there's love overflowing"

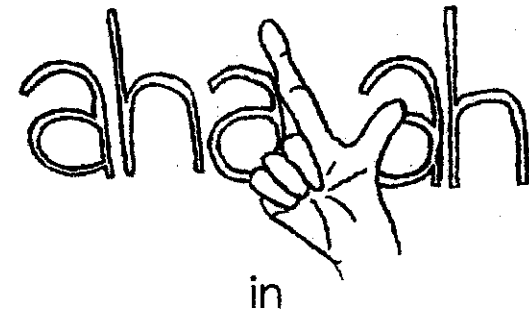

I Look To You (Advisor)

- ★ Communicate with the advisor multiple times a week
- ★ Update the advisor on anything that happens in the chapter
- ★ Make sure that all programs and purchases have been approved
- ★ Honor advisor appreciation month by planning a special program or creating a unique gift for our advisor

One Love (Sisterhood)

- ★ Maintain a strong sense of sisterhood throughout the year!
- ★ Hold functions and sleepovers for the purpose of strengthening our sisterhood
- ★ Make sure each member feels welcomed and excited to come to things
- ★ Inspire all members to be as active and involved as possible
- ★ Show each member how much they are appreciated with phone calls and cards
- ★ Appoint a sunshine girl to send out happy birthday cards and thank you notes
- ★ Have "ladybug" feelings at every chapter meeting.
- ★ Create a "MIT of the Month" program that allows MITs to work with me and learn about the jobs of a N'siah; bring her to the office, have her come shopping with me when we need things for programs, and most importantly give her the BBG feeling!
- ★ Plan separates programs because they are not just for bittker!
- ★ Have a chapter convention
- ★ Create Big Sisters/Little Sisters and plan programs based around them
- ★ Function with Gittlemen, our sister chapter!

I'll Stand By You (As Your Proud N'siah)

- ★ I will be an amazing role model throughout the whole year; be courteous, understanding, helpful, and supportive
- ★ I will remain dedicated to this chapter no matter what
- ★ I will make sure the year runs as smooth as possible by being organized and prepared for every meeting and function
- ★ I will work to give every B'nai B'rith Girl the BBG feeling
- ★ I will make myself available for every Ahavah member, whenever and wherever
- ★ I will bring a suggestion box to every meeting where members can make suggestions for improvement
- ★ I will eliminate the notion of paper members in our chapter by encouraging inactive members to attend events

Tell Me Something Good (Communication)

- ★ Send the weekly Sunday email to every member on time
- ★ Make the email informative, organized, and colorful
- ★ Have exec board members send their own Sunday updates to everyone explaining what they are currently working on
- ★ Make sure the Mazkirot are calling their lists by Wednesday of each week
- ★ Change the Mazkirot list a few times a year so they talk to new people
- ★ Complete the chapter buzz book by October and send it through email to save paper
- ★ Personally call members on occasion to make sure they're enjoying their time in the chapter
- ★ Work closely with the Katvanit to make sure that creative minutes are being turned in after every chapter and exec board meeting
- ★ Use snail mail invitations for big events!
- ★ Work with the Sunshine girl to create a list of birthdays!
- ★ Update our chapter website!

Hello, Goodbye (Attendance)

- ★ Promote meetings and functions in advance through e-mail, phone calls, text messages, etc
- ★ If attendance is not high enough, create incentives for going; to increase attendance at FC and ETC, start a lottery for those that sign up and the winners get a discount on bittker or an extra vote for when we vote on which guy chapter we go with
- ★ Call inactive members and enthusiastically persuade them to come to events
- ★ If we're functioning with another chapter, make sure the other chapter is promoting the function to their chapter
- ★ Ask members for input on function ideas
- ★ Work with the Katvanit to keep track of attendance at each event
- ★ Create an attendance book that goes to each chapter and regional event to help organize attendance

Home (Parents)

- ★ Send a parent version of the Sunday email to update parents on events and to help find houses that we can use for events
- ★ Hold a parent meeting in September for any questions a parent might have and so they get a better understanding of BBYO
- ★ Make sure all parents have my cell phone number for any other questions
- ★ Send special e-mails to parents regarding important events like FC, RC, YLC, ETC, and summer programs
- ★ Give cute thank-you cards to every home that hosts an Ahavah event

Friday (Programming)

- ★ Inform chapter members about functions and meetings at least a month in advance
- ★ Work with the S'ganit to plan fun and original functions: such as a salvation army style fashion show!
- ★ Decide at the first chapter meeting where we would like to set up an ongoing community service project
- ★ Utilize the Mazkirot to notify members about upcoming events while showing enthusiasm!
- ★ Program with every chapter in Michigan Region
- ★ Always ask for member input about function ideas; if we plan fun programs that members enjoy, this could boost attendance
- ★ Work closely with the S'ganit and Sh'lcha to plan outstanding programs
- ★ Encourage the MITs to help in planning functions! This can happen through an effective MIT board
- ★ Encourage the S'ganit to turn in program reports on time
- ★ Have at least two functions a month
- ★ Program with the fold of the month

Getting to Know You (Membership)

- ★ Work with the Aym Ha-Chaverot to plan a MIT "curriculum", teaching the MITs about this organization throughout the year
- ★ Pass out MIT books by the first MIT function, containing everything a MIT would want to know about BBYO so we can have MIT board elections early in October
- ★ Utilize the MIT board to the fullest extent, encouraging the exec board to communicate with their MIT counterpart frequently
- ★ Promote regional and international conclaves to the MITs, especially YLC and CLTC!!!
- ★ Make prospectives and new members feel welcome in the chapter
- ★ Remind seniors how important they are by planning unique senior appreciation programs

Gold Digger (Fundraising)

- ★ Work with the Gisbarit to make sure that the checkbook is balanced
- ★ Hold unique fundraisers every other month!!
- ★ Have an extremely successful Mr. AZA!!!
- ★ Promote these fundraisers as much as possible to the chapter and region
- ★ Have a program to educate members about Stand Up and choose our own Stand Up cause early in the year
- ★ Pass around a box at chapter meetings for donations for Stand Up
- ★ Donate at least \$293 at RC and ETC business meetings

Express Yourself

(Newspaper and Scrapbook)

- ★ Encourage every member to write one article for each newspaper
- ★ Create incentives for people to write articles!
- ★ Encourage each executive board member to write about their positions and what they are working on
- ★ Have newspapers done two weeks in advance to save time for editing!
- ★ Bring paper to each chapter meeting and function for girls to write articles
- ★ Create a "Ladybug of the month!" that profiles different girls for each newspaper so that way we can learn more about her!
- ★ Encourage everyone to give their own pictures to the Orchet for a scrapbook
- ★ Bring my own camera to every event and inspire others to do the same!

This Is How We Do It

(Traditions)

- ★ Continue following traditions while making new ones!
- ★ Have good and welfare after each meeting
- ★ Follow parliamentary procedure at every chapter and exec meeting
- ★ Sing the BBG pep song after every meeting
- ★ Teach members chapter, regional, and international cheers
- ★ Wear my BBG pin at every meeting and encourage others to do the same

Happy Days Are Here Again

(Regional Convention)

- ★ Explain to every member what Regial Convention is
- ★ Remind everyone throughout the practices and convention that it's all about the sisterhood!
- ★ Put effective committees together at the beginning of September
- ★ Work with the coordinators to finish song, cheer, and talent show before the first rc practice
- ★ Hold two practices a month in the months before RC
- ★ Promote practices and strongly encourage all members to attend each one
- ★ Hold a few extra RC practices to help members who may have trouble with song, cheer, or talent show
- ★ Create incentives for people to go to practices: Start a point system that gives members points for each RC practice they have attended and when they reach a certain amount of points, they get a discount on chapter spiritwear!

As If We Never Say Goodbye

(Bittker)

- ★ Plan and attend a fall and spring Bittker
- ★ Begin planning two months in advance
- ★ Elect coordinators at least three months in advance
- ★ Use the attendance point system to determine spots for Bittker
- ★ Vote on an AZA chapter to go to Bittker with during a chapter meeting
- ★ Promote Bittker like crazy and aim to fill up all the spots!
- ★ Incorporate original programming and traditions into the weekend
- ★ Assist the coordinators with anything and attend all of the meetings during the planning stage
- ★ If for some reason we cannot go to Bittker, still aim to go somewhere fun as a chapter to bond such as Cedar Point, Kalahari, or Frankenmuth!

Leaving on a Jet Plane

(Regional & International Involvement)

- ★ Promote Fall Conclave, Regional Convention, Young Leadership Conclave, and Elections Training Conclave like CRAZY!!
- ★ Aim for high attendance at regional functions and fundraisers
- ★ Promote council meetings to the chapter
- ★ Function with every chapter in the region to become more active in the region
- ★ Work with the Katvanit to promote summer programs to the entire chapter and set a realistic goal of how many people we can try to sign up!
- ★ Work with the Aym Ha-Chaverot to educate the MITS about important regional and international conclaves, especially YLC and CLTC!!

My Life Would Suck Without You

(Executive Board)

- ★ Be in constant communication with all exec board members
- ★ Be available 24/7 for any questions they may have
- ★ Have weekly calls or exec emails to make clear what everyone should be working on
- ★ Establish goals on an individual and group level at the beginning of the programming year
- ★ Use mid-year evals as a positive tool and evaluate the goals set at the beginning of the year
- ★ Have exec board sleepovers and dinners to help us bond!
- ★ Run executive board meetings before each chapter meeting
