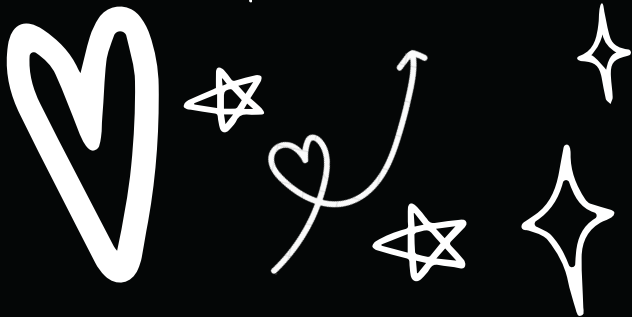


My sister B'nai B'rith girls,

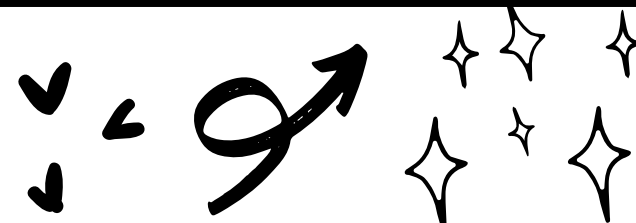


