Chapter

- Increase attendance

Programming

- Decorate the location of the event
- Have out-of-basement events
- Plan and execute great programming that everyone will enjoy
 - Include multiple folds of programming into each event
 - Send out a survey after each event
- Use out-of-the-box ideas

- Always respond within 24 hours to anyone
- Submit all Program Planning Forms and Event Evaluation Forms on time
- Check my email everyday and turn on alerts
- Be very organized and savvy with planning and scheduling
 - Keep a paper agenda specifically for BBYO things
- Attend every event within reason

Board
