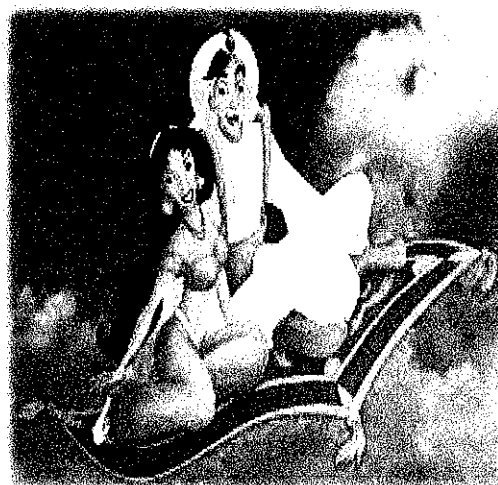

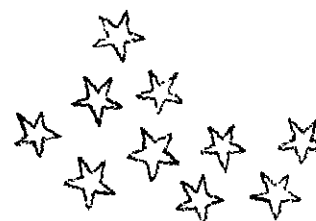

### Jafar (Recruitment)

- ☆ Contact any potential members and invite them to upcoming Ruach functions

- ☆ Manage the writing and sending of "Welcome to Ruach" cards to new members who just joined

### Iago (MIT's)

- ☆ Help coordinate older members to give the MIT's rides to events
