

# Coals and Ideas

If elected I would ...

Launch...

...an awards system in Randy Reisbord AZA. We annually win the Nathan Horowitz Rubin Cup at Regionals each year, but this initiative would bring this award system to our chapter with 3 awards. The awards would be called the Most Active, Most Improved, and the Best Board Member Award. The Godol and Advisors would both contribute to the selection of these awards, and the Godol could not win any award during his term. These awards would promote friendly competiveness and strive for greatness in each one of us.



...an international pen pal system. I have discussed this idea with Alex Weiner, Regional Shlicha of Miami Region BBYO #53, and she agreed wholeheartedly that this idea could succeed. The concept is that each member of Reisbord would be paired with a member of N'shamah BBG #2241. Every two weeks, the pairs would video chat over Skype. The pair would also become Facebook friends, and constant chatting would be promoted. At CLTC, I witnessed how large our order is, and frequent communication with an international AZA Chapter would international our chapter activities.



...a "Photo of the Week" would be sent to Reisbord in our weekly emails, as well as posted in our Facebook group. The pictures could be taken by the current Mazkir, who should bring a camera to each event. This photo could include a funny photo of Rachel Sweetie, Cameron Croft's mustache, Yoni, Ari, and Brad Beau, a picture from a recent project or frat night, or simply an amusing picture; the Mazkir would send to the Godol every week.



...a way for chapter and board members alike to not miss out on crucial information that has been distributed at meetings, and in general, to stay in the loop about what is going on in Reisbord.. This project I am starting, called Project Techboard, is a way for Reisbord to literally stay up to date with what is going on. There are three components to this project: a Reisbord Twitter account, a more effective use of the Reisbord website and Facebook page, and making flyers, videos, and memes which would be posted on our Facebook and website to promote events.



...on ensuring that Reisbord projects are not stressing "squeezing in" every fold (Judaism, Athletics, Community Service/Social Activism, Education, and Social) at the expense of having a fun project. Recently, at our projects, I've seen this happen. The S'gan and S'ganit would constantly have to quiet the two chapters, and often times the majority of us would want the project to be over with so we could "chill." I look to change this by holding weekly meetings with the S'gan (and S'ganit, both over webcam but ideally in person) to better incorporate these folds that meets the requirements and is actually fun for both chapters.



... opportunities for each member in our chapter to have his voice heard. Through Project Techboard, there is a designated "Member Speak Out page" on the website and thread on the Facebook page where anyone can post ideas or comments without sending out annoying notifications and spam.

#### Other Goals

- Continue to have a Bia Brother/Little Brother Night to promote fraternity and to make new friends.
- Do everything in my power to help us win the Nathan Horowitz Rubin Cup for the 4th straight year.
- Keep constant contact with the current regional and international Godol, both who I am very good friends with.
- Email and Facebook posts will be short and straight to the point, with correct grammar and plenty of shoutouts to good things in Reisbord, including Rachel Sweetie and advisors with good taste in music.
- Endorse the national BBG food. spooey, as the official Reisbord food. and bring this to every chapter event, including athletics. This custom will be known as Spooeyboard.
