PRIORITIES

Strengthening LOR's Leadership

Program Excellence

Growing AZA

- Grow our membership, while also ensuring that all members, new and old, are engaged
- Educated members on MRIHA which is BBYO's method of member recruitment, while establishing recruitment incentives
- Develop programming specifically catered to the members who will be in attendance
- Work with the Regional Moreh to establish LOR's Regional "Aleph Engagement Task Force"

Region-Wide Communication

- Revamp the "Cousin Chapter" initiative. For this initiative, 2
 chapters in our region will get paired up with one another and they
 will be known as "Cousin Chapters", cousin chapters will bond
 through cross chapter programming as well as a cross chapter
 convention at the end of the year

- Transition from Whatsapp to Groupme in order to stay in sync with the Grand Order

Jewish Enrichment

- Working with all chapter and regional Shlichim to establish programming that enables teens to find their jewish identity
- Establish an LOR Regional Kallah, a mini-convention that provides teens with an environment to expand upon their judaic knowledge and identity
- Encourage chapters to take part in international initiatives such as Stand UP and Speak UP

Fundraising and Finances
