J-serve

- Promote J-Serve to the entire Jewish community by posting flyers and sending out emails to all chapter presidents.
- Run a community service project at Regional Convention by contacting our Stand Up! organization and work with them to form a meaningful project.
- Keep the region informed about community service opportunities by posting on the Michigan Region Facebook group and including them in regional email updates.
- Form a goal with each chapter on how many hours of community service they wish to complete.
- Push for all chapters to have an ongoing community service project.
- Strive to enable Michigan Region to do more direct community service for our Stand Up! cause.
- Create a community service website and contact different organizations to help promote the events they need help with, as well as give chapters an easy way to have a direct link to local organizations.

Jewish Heritage

- Host a regional BBG Shabbat and invite every BBG by sending out invitations.
- Post tidbits of the weekly Torah portion in the BBYO office.
- Invite every member of Michigan Region to international Facebook groups about Judaism.
- Have teen lead Kabbalat Shabbat services once a month at the JCC.
- Construct a BBYO sukkah outside of the JCC and hold a 'Sukkot Schmooze' with snacks in the sukkah after school during the intermediate days of Sukkot.
- Work with members of the region who have attended Kallah to help plan a meaningful Jewish heritage night.

Social Action

- Promote social action to chapter and explain its importance at operation counterparts.
- Overcome the stereotype of social action being boring by creating packets for chapters to contact places that can give them information to improve their programming, and arranging speakers on different causes to talk at chapter events.
- Hold a social action program at all conclaves to help raise awareness and empower BBGs to take a stand on causes they care about.
- Attend at least one social action program of every BBG chapter and recognize them at council meetings.

J-serve

- Promote J-serve to the whole community by posting flyers and sending out email to allow everyone to participate
- Reach out to new organizations that the region doesn't do much work with and ask if they are interested in being involved in J-serve
- Form a committee to allow a 'leader' to be at each different service site

Counterparts

- Become friends with each and every counterpart to ensure that communication is not a struggle
- Call every counterpart weeks before Operation Counterparts and send follow up emails to ensure that all Shlichim can be in attendance
- Contact each counterpart twice a month and ensure that they are programming in the folds of Jewish Heritage, Social Action and Community Service
- Send out releases throughout the year that will assist Shlichim in ways that will improve Judaic services and new opportunities
- Host counterpart gatherings at least 3 times during the programming year

Little Sister Chapter

- Be the best big sister that any chapter could ever ask for
- Be in constant communication with the chapter N'siah
- Share my contact information with each and every girl of the chapter
- Attend at least one meeting or function of my little sister chapter each month
- Help in educating the chapter of new ideas and ways to go about handling situations
- Actively promote regional events to the chapter and it's importance to be regionally active
- Be a mentor and an information link to the regional life of BBYO of each member of my little sister chapter

AZA Counterpart

- Meet before the end of the programming year to form a timeline of events for the upcoming year
- Stay in constant communication with my AZA counterpart throughout the year
- Create a 'How To' guide with counterpart to be used at Operation Counterparts. Ex: 'How to use Build-A-Prayer' or 'how to call and organization your chapter wants to volunteer at'
- Have weekly phone conversations with AZA counterpart so we know that we are on the same page at all times
- Make decisions together and stick by our word and support the choices made by each of us individually

Regional Board

- Attend all council and general board meetings throughout the year.
- Arrive at all regional events with other BBGs to increase attendance within the region.
- Serve as a role model to all BBGs by being positive and helpful throughout the whole year.
- Voice my opinion in ways that I think will strengthen the region.
- Respond to all emails within 24 hours of receiving them.
- Keep in close contact with regional board by forming a lifelong friendship with each member.
