RLTI

• Practical Programming

- It does not make sense for the region to hold its leaders to high standards of success, but not give them effective tools to meet those standards
- I want to retool the programming at RLTI to teach essential information, such as how to balance BBYO with school, creating a year long calendar, etc.
- Programs will deal with real situations, i. e. parliamentary procedure in a mock meeting

• Problem Solving

 Each chapter will have a problem solving sessions with a regional officer to combat specific issues

Chapters

• Chapter Specific Strategies

- Not all chapters are the same; what works for Allentown may not work for West Chester
- Combat specific chapter problems (i. e. lack of recruitment in Scranton)
- Give Kehilah the tools they need to split within the next two years

• Raise Chapter Quality in All Areas

- Chapter programming has fallen to the wayside; we need to ensure that each chapter has and uses a programming form
- Every chapter will have a constitution
- Work with chapters to form partnerships with Jewish hubs (JCC's, Synagogues, etc.) in their communities to open up long lasting sources of recruitment

Meaningful Committees

- Useless committees will be eliminated and replaced with productive ones or discarded entirely; quality over quantity
- Specific committees will be for nonboard and younger members only

Let Every Voice be Heard

- More flexibility in timeframe for motions to be sent in
- This is your region! When you have something to say, regardless of experience on chapter board, expect your words to be put into action
